

### The Pastor's Voice

### **Announcements**

The world was surprised this morning by the announcement of the Roman Catholic Pope that he would be resigning at the end of the month. Such an event has not taken place in hundreds of years. Usually a Pope serves until death. In this case, health issues seem to be in play and the 85 year old pontiff has indicated his intention to live a life of prayer following his retirement.

As we shared yesterday in worship, we noted that Jesus made an announcement to his disciples at a particular point in their time of following him that also took them by surprise. He said, "The Son of Man must undergo great suffering, and be rejected by the elders, chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day raised." (Luke 8:22)

As we begin the Lenten season this week, we prepare ourselves to enter a season of self-examination and repentance. It is a time to study, to learn, to grow in our faith, and to acknowledge our sins and need for forgiveness. If Christ would suffer for us, we should be ready to consider the reasons why. And we should consider what a walk of faith in Christ should mean for us daily.

Jesus' announcement caught his disciples by surprise, but we have no excuse for ignoring his resurrection and calling on this side of the cross, that is, unless we forget that he told us, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me." (Luke 9:23)


