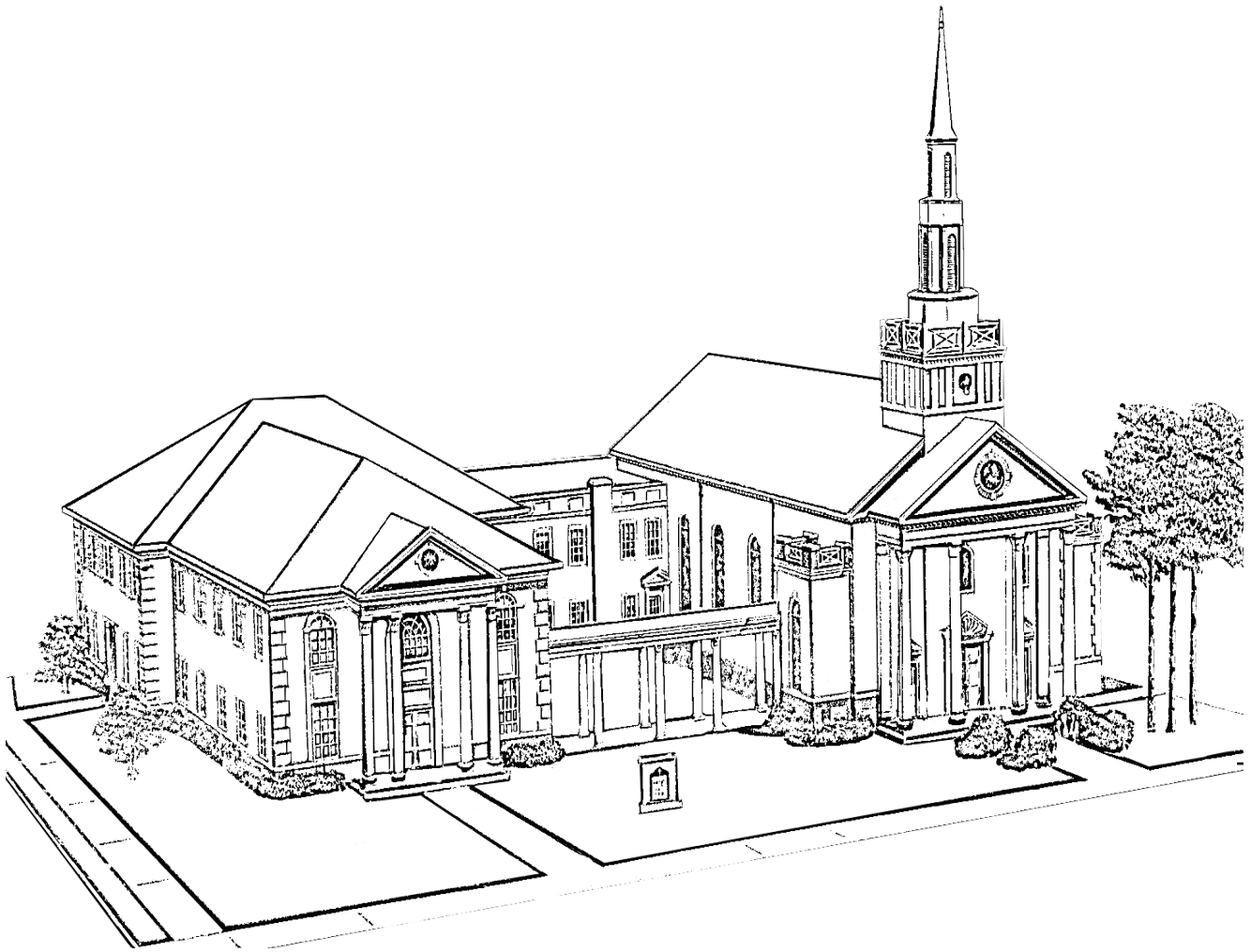

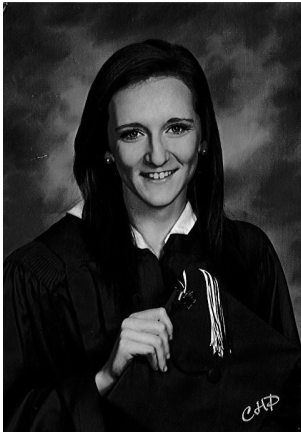

# Congratulations to our 2016 Whiteville High School Graduates!



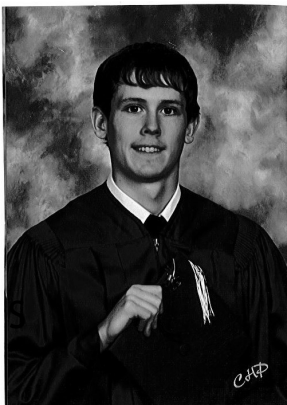
*Megan Allison Lynn*

## Mission Moment

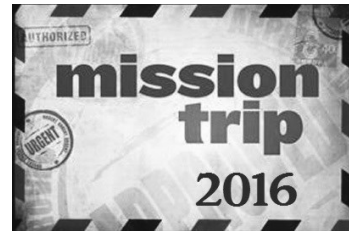
