

Psalm 142:4 and Isaiah 61:1-3; Mathew 25:31-34

Leader: I looked on my right hand, and beheld, but there was no one who would know me: refuge failed me; no one cared for my soul.

People: The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord has anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; He has sent me to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them who are bound:
