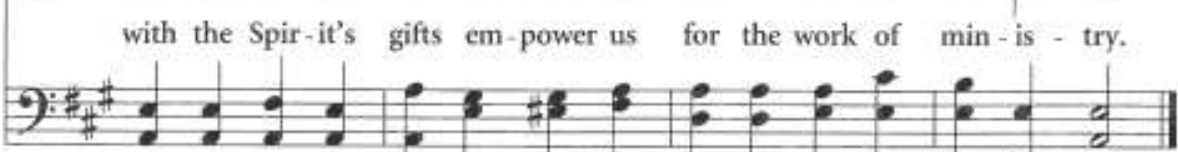
Lest the church ne-glect its mis-sion, and the gos-pel go un-heard,
