The Advent Wreath

Lighting the Christ Candle

- Leader: Hope, peace, joy, and love. Four candles, four promises continually offered to us by God, and all of them manifest in one candle tonight.

- People: Tonight, we light the last candle in the Advent Wreath—the Christ candle. In Christ we find light and life, and the challenge to be like him, answering his call and following in his footsteps.
- Leader: For a child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders, and he is named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)
- All: We rejoice in God's steadfast presence in our lives, and in God's manifesting the peace, love, and justice of God. Come to us, Lord Jesus. Be born in us this night, in our hearts, our minds, and our lives. May the light of your life be kindled in us, and lead us to the shining truth, of God with us, God for us, and God in us. Amen.


