

## PASTOR'S CORNER



As we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus this year on RESURRECTION SUNDAY, April 4, 2021, may we also take time to ask God to help us remember the celebratory events—as well as the agonizing events—of Holy Week which served as a horrific prelude to the VICTORY of Resurrection Sunday! Those events include: the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on what we call PALM SUNDAY; MAUNDY THURSDAY, where Jesus at the Last Supper in the Upper Room with His disciples, broke the bread and shared the cup as He symbolized in sharing those elements His broken body and shed blood and where He also washed the feet of those disciples, His followers, to show them the epitome of humility and how to serve one another (Maundy = short for the Latin, "mandatum,"

meaning "command/mandate" = A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another (John 13:34); the agony of Jesus praying in the Garden of Gethsemane to His Heavenly Father, Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me, nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done (Luke 22:42); the mockery of a trial and the physical abuse and torture Jesus endured; the brutal crucifixion as Jesus hung on a cross between two thieves on a hill called Mount Calvary; His burial in the borrowed tomb of Joseph of Arimathea; and then His glorious resurrection—as He defeated death and arose victoriously from the tomb!

In light of this brief summary above of the events we have heard of and learned about through the years concerning HOLY WEEK, I am very grateful that my wife, Joy, was able to be with us on PALM SUNDAY. I hope and pray you were blessed and enlightened with her teaching and presentation of "CHRIST IN THE PASSOVER!" As we reflect on God's unconditional love for us through the gift of His Son, Jesus, the Christ . . . the sacrificial Lamb of God, who was *slain from the foundation of the world* (Revelation 13:8) . . . for the salvation of the world . . . I am reminded how Joy was inspired by God several years ago to write, *Virgin Mary, Mother of God, Creation of God!* Can we ever possibly imagine—or seek to understand—the agony, thoughts, and reflections that Mary definitely must have experienced in her mind, heart, and soul as she personally witnessed the crucifixion . . . death . . . burial . . . and resurrection of her first-born Son, Jesus Christ—the promised Messiah—who also would become her Savior?!? Mary gave birth to Jesus! Jesus, her Son, gave Mary the gift of salvation. God willing, I will share this poignant writing at our Maundy Thursday Communion and Tenebrae Worship Service. Copies also will be available in the church office, if you would like to obtain a copy. May we all thank God for His unspeakable gift of love through Jesus as we seek to share our faith wherever we go!

Hallelujah! What a Savior! Hallelujah! Christ is risen! Hallelujah! Christ is risen indeed—just as He said! Hallelujah! May we have a hope-filled day—each and everyday—as we joyfully celebrate the truth that HOPE IS ALIVE FOREVER!




