

PASTOR'S CORNER



As we have worshiped together during this Lenten Season, I have tried to share through the sermons about the importance of our words . . . and especially what Jesus was trying to teach us with His last words from the cross! I hope by now you not only have heard once again, "The Seven Last Words of Jesus" as He uttered them from the cross, but that you also have memorized them! Jesus' "words" truly can have a meaningful and significant impact on our lives . . . IF we take them to heart! According to Holy Scripture, these brief—yet profound—statements were made by Jesus as He was being crucified on the cross—even as He was hanging there under extreme stress . . . gasping for His next breath . . . and enduring torturous pain! Each word (statement) is a final and last message from Jesus,

the Savior and Lord . . . the Son of God . . . the promised Messiah . . . to help us see the depth of His love for all of us and for all of humanity! In review, the number "seven" is the biblical number for completion, fulfillment, wholeness, and salvation! So, from the cross, in His dying breaths, Jesus dealt with—and taught us the importance of—these seven issues: FORGIVENESS of sin . . . ASSURANCE of salvation . . . ADOPTION into the family of God . . . ABANDONMENT and loneliness . . . NEEDS physical and spiritual . . . COMPLETION of a task . . . VICTORY and home going! The "words" for your reference are as follows:

Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do. Luke 23:34

Verily, I say unto you, today you will be with Me in Paradise. Luke 23:43

Woman, behold your son! Behold your mother! John 19:26-27

My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me? Mark 15:34

I thirst! John 19:28

It is finished! John 19:30

Father, into Your hands I commit my spirit! Luke 23:46

Words! Words!! WORDS!!! Let's please ask God to help and lead us in using our words carefully . . . because the words we say—and how we say them—truly do reflect who we are and what is in our heart!


