## PASTOR'S CORNER



"Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly beyond all that we ask or imagine, according to the power that works in us."

(Ephesians 3:20)

Exceedingly, abundantly, and beyond. These three incredibly powerful words are promised us by our loving God. This is an especially appropriate verse for right now, as I believe this ties in beautifully with Easter and everything it means to us. As we all know, right at this precise moment in the Biblical calendar, Jesus is planning to accept the horrors of the cross for our

behalf. And this is exactly what He came here to do for us. He has willingly entered into the week of Passion so that He might now be able to pass on His healing strength to you and me.

In church this past Sunday, I had mentioned my attendance at a concert over the weekend where three popular Christian musicians played a wonderful variety of praise and worship music - this to an audience of thousands of jubilant participants. People came from all over the world including Indonesia and Ireland... Myrtle Beach and Whiteville. Among the songs played was one that was entitled "When I Fight I'll Fight On My Knees". What a perfectly apt description of the cross! His battle plans for us are acceptance, patience, love, and kindness. After all, God came riding in on a lonely little donkey - this, to put on display His humility for us. I've said it before in the pulpit, and I'm sure that I will say it again: In the midst of my busiest days I need to always pause and remember the importance of 'getting out of my own way'. While one or two - or four or six different things are going on all at once in our beautiful ministries, we all must slow down long enough to "LET GO AND LET GOD!"

This same line of thinking also goes for our local businesses, corporations, institutions, schools, sports teams, and houses of worship, as well. With God's guidance; together we can do so much. *Exceedingly means to an unusual degree. Abundantly means generously, lavishly or profusely. Beyond means surpassing all limitations.* Let us ponder these definitions... Then imagine - imagine what God could do in our own lives. Imagine what He could do in your life. What could He do in the life of First Baptist Whiteville? What answers will He send to our prayers?

Now let us bump it up several notches. Let us bump it up well beyond what we may think is even possible. Let's allow our faith to rest here for a while. Let it rest on the exceptional, on the extraordinary, on the supernatural - because this is what Jesus promises to bring to us now that we're into the Holy week.


