


### PASTOR'S CORNER



"There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved." **Acts 4: 12** 

The Easter season is now fast upon us. Spring is in the air and a sense of transformation is all around. What was previously brown and parched is fast becoming green with fresh buds bringing with them the promise of new life. To be sure, the pollen is here - and what a nuisance it is. But it will be gone soon enough, as God will see to it. Throughout my travels where I am exposed to people of different cultures and faith paths, a common topic will often

emerge and reemerge: With the many religions that are out there, why is Jesus Christ the only way to God? Here I sense that old word pluralism is creeping back in once again. Indeed, one of the most prevalent criticisms of Christianity is that it is too narrow. The fact is, many people refuse to believe that there is only one way to get to Heaven. Christians are oftentimes criticized for implying that they are somehow better than those who do not believe in Jesus Christ. But of course, the very reason that Christians believe Jesus Christ is the way to Heaven is because He said so Himself when He told us, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me." (John 14:6).

Words like "teach", "sent", "do", and "give", are cornerstones to the followers of Christ. People can spot it in us. It's how we live and it's why we're not like anyone else. We rarely take a day off. Because we don't want to. Because we don't have to. Because for the Christian, this is what it looks like to live a life on mission. Trust me, once you're on - you **DON'T** want to get off! And here's an added bonus: God already provides for us ahead of time everything He requires back in return. "Love thy neighbor as thyself"... It all stems from a place of His indwelling love. As beloved members of First Baptist Whiteville we are able to give back what has already generously been given to us. There's simply nothing else like it. Is there any other way that I could possibly want to live? We engage in a lifestyle of servanthood because we can. I can give back because I've been given to. Let me now remember to give back to my church, which promises to give so much to me! Let us prepare for the mission field ahead. Give graciously to God from an overflowing heart. He will bless the love that you give - and then expand, multiply, and increase it **IN WAYS UNTOLD!** 



## MAUNDY THURSDAY


