## Pastor's Corner "SIGNS OF THE TIMES"



Some have asked in light of the Coronavirus and the "peaceful protests" which have turned to looting, violence, hostility, rebellion, crime, murder, death and destruction in our land, are these signs of the "end of the world?" I definitely **am not** a "conspiracy theorist," but I definitely **am** a believer in God's Holy Word. I **do not** even pretend to understand all the mysteries of the "end times," but I truly believe scripture tells us we **do not** know the day or the hour, but we are to **watch** for the "signs" of Jesus' return. We read in Matthew 24:36, But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.

As the saying goes, "We do not know **what** the future holds, but we do know **Who** holds the future! I found the following list of "signs" that we may study and consider as we **trust God** and **know** that **He is with us**, while at the same time, as Matthew 24:44 tells us, **Therefore**, **you also be ready**, **for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.** 

#### SOME SIGNS OF THE END TIMES AS RECORDED IN THE BIBLE

- 1. People will be deceived by false prophets, and by people who claim to be Divine. (Matthew 24:24)
- 2. There will be severe earthquakes, famines, plagues, and severe weather conditions. (Matthew 24:3, 7; Luke 21:11; Mark 13:8)
- 3. The gospel will be preached in all the world and unto all nations. (Matthew 24:14; Acts 2:17)
- 4. There will be excessive eating, drinking, and an increase in divorces. (Matthew 24:37-38)
- 5. There will be an increase in homosexuality. (II Timothy 3:1-3)
- 6. There will be an increase in children rebelling and being disobedient to their parents. (Mark 13:12; II Timothy 3:2)
- 7. Man's knowledge will increase drastically. (Daniel 12:4)
- 8. There will be a revival of the practices of the occult: witchcraft, sorcery, astrology, soothsaying, and magic. (Revelation 21:8; 9:21)

# REOPENING THE CHURCH

The Committee to Reopen First Baptist Church is planning for our soft opening beginning in August. Plans include the following:


Continue the Wednesday Night Drive-Through Supper through August. The Music Ministry will provide the meal for the August Wednesday Night Drive-Through Supper.

On August 2<sup>nd</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>, we will offer a general Sunday School session for **adults** in the Fellowship Hall. Face masks will be required and we will be practicing social distancing by placing chairs strategically throughout the Fellowship Hall to accommodate up to 36 people. We are enlisting volunteers from our Sunday School classes to teach on these days. Please be patient as we are in a learning curve as to how to offer services to as many of our members as possible. Sunday School will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. and end at 10:30 a.m. in order for individuals to return to their homes to listen via internet or radio. Members of the committee and Deacon volunteers will be directing the flow of traffic in and out of the building. **Reservations are required**. The Sunday School teacher for both of these Sundays will be **Karen Dawsey**.

On August 9<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> we will open the sanctuary to the congregation for worship services. In addition to staff, we can accommodate up to 36 participants in the sanctuary with social distancing. If we exceed the number of reservations for the sanctuary, we will open the Fellowship Hall and allow participants to view the service on a screen through the internet. Families may sit together in the sanctuary but others must social distance. Children are welcome for our worship services in the Sanctuary. They must sit with parents in designated family pews and remain with family members during entrance and exit from the building. There will be <u>no</u> Children's Service or nursery provided on these days. Masks will be required and we will have volunteers to assist with seating, exit and entrance options. **Reservations will be required.** 

Again, we ask your patience in advance as we are preparing to fully open our church. We welcome your suggestions and ideas. If you have questions or concerns, please contact the church office at 910-642-2139 and they will forward them to the committee. Please continue to pray for our committee as we move forward in opening FBC. Thank you for your interest, support, and prayerful concern.
