### PASTOR'S CORNER

We love you and we thank God for the privilege of serving Him with you here at First Baptist Church in Whiteville.

I also THANK everyone who helped in any way to make the sanctuary so exquisitely beautiful with **ALL** of the decorations. We all are truly grateful and we appreciate the beauty . . . and we also **THANK** each and every musician for the beautiful and worshipful music throughout this holy season.

As we celebrated the Lord's Supper together on New Year's Eve, I am reminded of something God inspired me to write sometime ago. As we shared the bread and the cup together, we celebrated that God has provided for everyone in the world the **GIFT of SALVATION** through His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ--the promised Messiah--Whose birth we proclaimed during our Sunday School lessons and our worship services together in December. I want to share the following original writing with you as a reminder to all of us—including myself—that it is NOT our good works, or our own righteousness, but it is ONLY through Jesus Christ—**GOD'S PERFECT SON ALONE**—that we can be made right in our relationship with a Holy God and that we can have access to Him!
