I hope and pray you had a very Merry Christmas wherever you celebrated it this year! One of our most special and traditional Christmas celebrations at First Baptist Church of Whiteville is the CHRISTMAS EVE CANDLELIGHT COMMUNION SERVICE. It is always a well-attended service, and it certainly is a beautiful way for us to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, the Savior of the world. The lights of the Chrismon Tree and the lights of the candles remind us truly that Jesus IS the LIGHT of the world! 
