



Music Notes



Our journey through the **Lenten Season** begins with Ash Wednesday on March 2.

The season of **Lent** is forty days in length excluding Sundays. The practice of a forty-day preparation period began in the Christian church during the third and fourth centuries.

The number *forty* carries biblical significance based on the forty years Israel spent in the wilderness and Jesus' forty-day fast in the wilderness.

Realizing that the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ are at the heart of the Christian gospel, we journey through Lent in preparation for Good Friday and Easter (two of the most significant celebrations of the Christian year.)

Thus, Lent is a season of preparation and repentance. During the Lenten Season we are challenged to make our hearts ready for remembering Jesus' passion and celebrating Jesus' resurrection.

As a period of preparation, Lent has historically included the instruction of persons for baptism and profession of faith on Easter Sunday. As Christians we are called to deepen our devotion and commitment to God.


