TOR'S CORNER



We are on a journey together at First Baptist Church of Whiteville and I am thankful to you as a loving congregation for giving me the honor and privilege to serve as your Interim Pastor. Who would have ever thought when we met in February that we would get to worship together for a few Sunday and Wednesday services, and then be mandated by our national, state, and local authorities to "keep our protective social distance" from each other as a very wise precaution because of the Coronavirus? I laughingly have said that as a "hugging and hand-holding pastor," this "distancing" has been a totally different way of getting to relate with each other since we first met! However, aren't we BLESSED and THANKFUL to have the ability to broadcast our Morning Worship Services on our AM and FM Radio Stations and to Live Stream on our church's Facebook? These various forms of media have surely become helpful ways for all of us to communicate during these very challenging days! We definitely are praying to God, in Jesus' Name, for our land and the entire world to be healed from this "plague" that has invaded us all!

During the Lenten Season we looked at "The Seven Last Words of Jesus from the Cross." On Palm Sunday we emphasized Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem as proclaimed by all four (4) of the Gospel writers, and on Resurrection Sunday, we celebrated that Jesus defeated death and rose from the tomb, another triumphant event which also was recorded by Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. On Sunday, April 19th, we looked again at passages in all four (4) Gospels and in Acts 1:8 where the writers reported that Jesus commissioned us to "go into all the world" to make disciples, to baptize, and to teach the GOOD NEWS--while remembering His promise that He would be with us always!

A minister friend of mine, Dan Griffin, with whom I served at the First Baptist Church in Winston-Salem, North Carolina and who now lives in Texas, used to say, "There is nothing as over as Christmas!" That seems to be so true after all the gifts are unwrapped, the feasts are shared, and the traveling and festivities are completed. I think that many people often feel that way about Easter. They seem to experience a "let down" after Holy Week and the excitement of the "build up" in celebration of the resurrection! But may I remind us, that it was AFTER His resurrection that Jesus gave us His GREAT COMMISSION! Jesus told His disciples then, and He is telling us now, that their work was--and our work is--to "go forth" with the GOOD NEWS! His WORDS of truth, faith, peace, and love are as alive and well as ever—and HIS MESSAGE OF HOPE is especially needed in these dark days and troubled times, aren't they?!?

Several years ago, God inspired me with a very simple "Plan of Salvation" that I would like to share with you. Hopefully, you will find it easy to memorize this and perhaps it will serve as another tool to help as we seek to fulfill Jesus' GREAT COMMISSION to all of us. As we are "commissioned" to share HIS GOOD NEWS with others, I call it "The A, B, C's and D of Salvation!" I shared it from the pulpit on Sunday, April 26th. We also have included it on page 6 in this issue of **THE CONTACT** to help you learn and memorize this approach as God leads you.

Let's ask God to please help us learn our "A, B, C's and D" as we have the joy of sharing the Gospel reaching UP to Him . . . reaching OUT to others . . . and reaching IN to each other in ministry and service.
