

The naming of a Pastor Selection Committee is to begin soon and will be conducted jointly by the church Nominating and Personnel Committees in a process directed by the church by-laws. A part of that process is gathering church member input for a period of 10 days prior to the naming of the Pastor Selection Committee. That 10-day period is going to be January 19-28, 2015, and during that time church members are urged to recommend specific individuals for service on that committee. Additional information about the selection process is given below in an excerpt taken from The Church Policy Manual.

"The Pastor Selection Committee shall consist of 5 members with 3 of the members being of one gender and 2 of the members being of the opposite gender. Two alternates shall be appointed, one of each gender, who shall join the committee, if needed to replace any members who may become unable to serve. The Personnel Committee and the Nominating Committee, acting together and chaired by the Chairperson of the Nominating Committee, shall appoint the Pastor Selection Committee and shall select the chairperson of the Committee.

For a period of 10 days prior to the appointment of the Pastor Selection Committee, church members shall be given the opportunity to recommend candidates for The Pastor Selection Committee. Recommendations for said committee from the church members shall be turned in to the church office and shall be on a form available at said office."

Members of the Interim Pastor Selection and Pulpit Supply Committee are eligible for appointment; however, if they accept the position, they must resign from the Interim Pastor Selection Committee.

In addition <u>The Church Policy Manual</u> advises the selection of members who have a "broad knowledge of the church and its congregation, who represent the various ministries, programs and age groups of the church, and who will be available and willing and able to travel as necessary."

Forms for making recommendations for the Pastor Selection Committee will be available in the church office, and a form is printed in this issue of **The Contact**. These forms should be completed and **returned to the church by Wednesday, January 28**.
