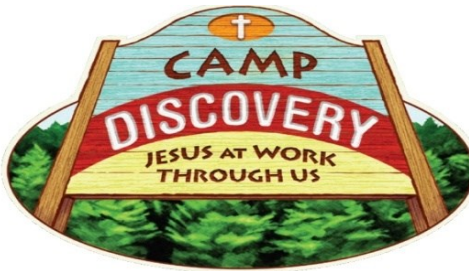

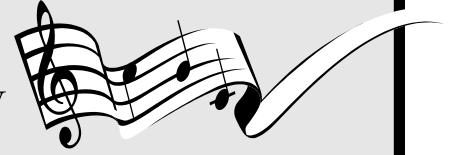

Dear Church Family,

The following recommendation came to us from Carol Greer who is one of our Primary School teachers and of course, a long time member of our church. We discussed it at our Deacon's meeting and we also endorsed it as a great idea for our children and also community involvement from FBC. I explained it at Prayer Meeting last Wednesday night but for all who were not there, the following information explains what we are talking about.

“GIVE FIVE--- READ FIVE” (Sent to the Primary and Elementary teachers from the Superintendent and Curriculum/Teacher support person)

We are participating in NC's Give Five – Read Five campaign. We are asking parents, businesses, churches, etc. to donate books or money to this program. Our goal is to give five books to each of our students to take home and read over the summer. We focus on providing five books because research from Harvard shows that reading five books helps students to better retain literacy skills over the summer. Please ask your students, churches, and community members to help with this initiative.

Please purge your children's books at home and donate some to this cause. They may be “gently used or new.” Bring them to the Fellowship Hall Tables against the wall. Carol said she would get them to the schools for us. You can also make a donation toward purchase of new books. Monetary contributions may be made to First Baptist Church or Carol Greer.
